Giants Neck Heights Association meetings are public forums where your Board of Governors discusses issues and topics relevant to the running of your neighborhood association. If you have any concerns about an issue, you can express them during the public comment portion of the meeting.

During this time, you can talk to the BOG to let them know how you feel on a subject. Once you present your viewpoint and those attending the meeting hear it, it may make an impact on the decisions being made.

At the meeting, be sure to:

- Look at the agenda for the topics being discussed.
- Select the topic you have concerns about for your public comment.
- When the opportunity for public comment comes up, raise your hand and state your name and address.
- Speak for under three minutes about the issue or read something you have written about the issue.

You may also send a request to the Board of Governors asking that something be added to the agenda in advance of the meeting.
