

COVID-19 JULY 4TH WEEKEND WRISTBAND PILOT

Due to the difficult times we're in and the interest in testing out some sort of beach ID, we're trying a pilot program this weekend for Friday, July 3rd - Sunday, July 5th.

Rocky Neck is operating at 25% capacity and that overflow often trickles down to our street with people trying to access our beach. Rocky Neck will be policing their border and enforcing no walk-ins.

Please note, this is in no way meant to be intrusive or a hassle.

Each person will get one wristband for the day. If you have guests or family with you, they will also all get their own wristband. Kids do not need a wristband.

To minimize the attendants interaction we'll be handing out wristbands three ways:

1. If you come into the turn around - you'll already have your decal or parking tag. The attendant will hand you (through your window) one wristband per person. (Kids do not need them.)
2. If you go right to the parking lot - the attendant will hand you one wristband per person. (Note - the attendant may not know you were already given wristbands if you went to the turn around first, so please be patient if they ask you.)
3. If you are walking down to the beach - a staff member will have our grand list printed - you'll be asked your last name (our list is alphabetical).
 - a. We know there will be some holes in this process - for example - if you are a new resident of the Heights, you won't be on the grand list. So if that's the case, just give us your new address and we'll add you to the list. Again, this is not meant to be intrusive. It will also help us to have up to date records.

Other items to know:

Please be respectful to the attendants - they are simply doing their job. If you have a question about this process/test pilot, please see a board member.

If everyone can wear their wristband, you'll minimize the chance that you're asked if you need a new one.

This is not set in stone. We've heard enough interest on this topic and we'd like to see how it works. There are a lot of unknowns, but we hope that everyone will be patient and work with us to figure out if this is a viable solution.

We will have the PD on staff Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

We do want your feedback! If you thought this worked well, please let us know. If you thought this was a bad idea, also let us know. We need this feedback from membership to determine if this is something we should bring to the Association to vote on.
