- Committee purpose is to explore options for Family Member Identification at/on the beach. Rationale:
 - Rocky Neck is at ½ capacity (500 cars) they don't turn away walk-ins.
 - o Town beaches are turning away non residents
 - People coming in through our road and try to access our beach or rocky neck.
 - Major issue for employees and lots of board members and members of the association trying to manage.
 - o Important for our staff to have something to prevent non-residents from walking onto the beach.
 - o 600 families in the association
 - Need to know that the people entering the beach are association members

Ideas brainstormed

- Privacy fence that will rest on the sand by the flagpole
- Tags (8 years or up are required to wear a wrist band purchase them when you pay your taxes)
- o Keychain
- Printed, laminated card with a hole punch to put on wrist, neck, bag wherever they want to put it. 2 or 3 per household then they can buy more.
- Listing of members and their address to check ownership
- o Tag on person and Flag for the beach
- Daily code texted to all members
- Hire a security officer to monitor the beach and let board member know if someone is not displaying their tag (an official looking person who is not part of the association)
